The Cabinet's Regulation No. 360 (adopted 9 June 2020) "Epidemiological Safety Measures

for the Containment of the Spread of COVID-19 Infection" (Cabinet's Regulation)\* paragraph 3.<sup>1</sup> "The Centre for Disease Prevention and Control shall, based on the information provided by the European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control, publish on its website a list of those countries to which special precautionary and restrictive measures are applicable, and shall also indicate those countries where such spread of COVID-19 infection has been registered which can cause a serious threat to the public health. The relevant precautionary and restrictive measures shall be applied from the day following the publication of the abovementioned list."
